


THE PLIGHT ON CAMPUS

As a result, four students expressed an interest in starting something new at CAU.

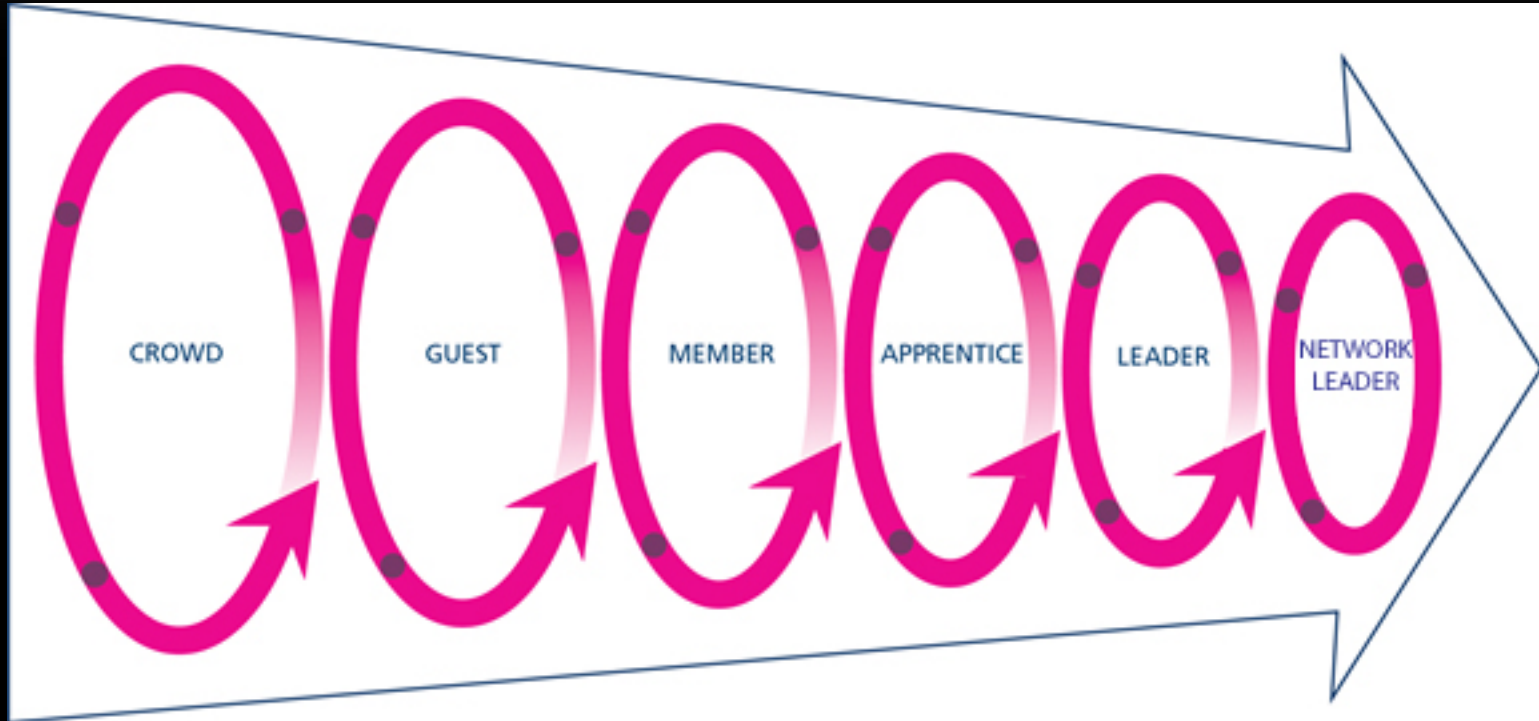
